**ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE CLASS B HIGHWAY**

The Town Board of the Town of Alto, Fond du Lac County, Wisconsin, upon a majority vote of the Town Board with a quorum present and proper notice having been given, adopts this ordinance to designate a Town highway as a Class B highway:

1. Designation of Highways. Brandon Road from Liner Road to Oak Mound Road is designated as Class B highways and is subject to the weight limits set forth in Wis. Stat., § 348.16(2).
2. Signage. The Town Chairperson, or his designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above-described highway on or before the date this ordinance goes into effect.
3. Exceptions. Any motor vehicle whose operation is pick up or delivery, including operation for the purpose of moving or delivering supplies or commodities to or from any place of business or residence that has an entrance on a Class B highway, may pick up or deliver on a Class B highway without complying with the Class B weight limits imposed by this ordinance.
5. Violations. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-described highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in Wis. Stat., § 348.16(2). Violations of this ordinance are subject to forfeitures of not less than \$50 nor more than \$500, plus the costs of prosecution and attorneys' fees for each violation. Each trip in violation of this ordinance constitutes a separate offense. The Town may additionally seek injunctive relief, abatement orders, and other equitable relief as necessary to prevent further violations.
6. Effective Date. This ordinance goes into effect upon its publication and the erection of signage as required by the Department of Transportation.
